## Have your say on a Local Toilet Strategy for Caerphilly County Borough

Caerphilly County Borough Council has a responsibility to assess the community's need for toilets and to put a plan in place to meet identified needs. The Council must prepare and publish a local toilet strategy by 31st May 2019. To help identify need, the council is seeking views of residents and visitors to the county borough. The survey will run from **3rd September to 28th September** 2018.

For the purpose of this survey and strategy, the term toilet includes changing facilities for babies and changing places facilities for people with disabilities. These can be located in public buildings such as libraries and community centres, private buildings such as cafes and shops as well as public toilets maintained by the council.
