

## PARENT AND TODDLER CHILDCARE CHOICES

### Parent and Toddler and Ti a Fi

**Group's** provide play opportunities for the child and social opportunities for parents to meet in an informal atmosphere and at a reasonable cost.

The parent/carer must stay with the child throughout the session. They do not need to be registered with Care and Social Services Inspectorate Wales.

Parent and Toddler groups provide a happy, safe and stimulating environment for children to meet, socialise and play.

The groups are mainly for children under 2 <sup>1/2</sup> years old.

Each group is different and reflect the needs of the local families.

It is a chance for parents, carers or anyone in a parental position to meet other parents and make friends. Parents can share information and air problems.

### WPPA (Wales Pre-school Playgroups Association)
