CROESO I RHISGA

Mae'r enw Rhisga yn dyddio'n ôl i'r 12fed ganrif o leiaf ac yn tarddu o "yr is case" - neu 'y cae isaf' sy'n cyfeirio at leoliad y dref yn rhan isaf yr ucheldiroedd.

Hyd at ddechrau'r 19eg ganrif, roedd cymeriad Rhisga bron yn gwbl wledig, ond tyfodd Rhisga yn ganolfan ddiwydiannol bwysig oherwydd cyfoeth ei thiroedd. O dan y dref roedd un o'r mathau mwyaf gwerthfawr o lo - glo ager - a ddenai arloeswyr cynnar i'r ardal.

Mae copa Twmbarlwm, a'r fryngaer a'r ffos o Oes yr Haearn, yn edrych dros Risga, ac mae rhai haneswyr wedi honni mai gorsaf arwyddo Rufeinig ydoedd, gan fod modd ei gweld yn glir o'r gwersylloedd yng Nghaerllion a Gelligaer.

WELCOME TO RISCA

The name Risca dates back to at least the 12th Century and derives from "yr is case" meaning "the lower enclosure," referring to its location at the lower end of upland areas.

Risca until the beginning of the 19th Century was almost entirely rural in character. The formation and growth of Risca as an important industrial centre was due primarily to its geological assets, for beneath its lands was one of the most sought after varieties - steam coal - and it was that which attracted early pioneers to the area.

Did you know?

The mountain top of Twmbarlwm, with its Iron Age hill fort and mote, dominates Risca and some historians have averred that this was a Roman signalling station, as it is easily visible from their camps at Caerleon and Gelligaer.

What to see

Located in the old Risca Workmen's Hall, Risca Industrial History Museum has many displays illustrating the industrial and social history of the area. These include a fully restored Edwardian chemist's shop and a wheelwright's and blacksmith's shop. There are also many displays on industrial transport, coal and iron mining and many interesting railway artefacts.
