## Guidance for Foster Carers to record health appointments and medication prescribed

In order to keep an accurate record of all health appointments children and young people attend and any medication that is provided, it will be necessary for carers to complete and keep up to date the attached health appointments record.

The form will be provided by your link worker when a child is placed with you. You will need to complete the form as and when a child/ young person:

- Is registered with a GP
- Is registered with a Dentist
- Is taken to an Optician
- Has any medical appointments
- Has any dental appointments
- Attends A&E departments for any reason
- Has any childhood illnesses

When a child/ young person is prescribed medication for any reason, the name of the medication, the type of illness and the dosage of the medication must be recorded.

The health appointment form must be taken to the child/ young persons health assessment.

At every health assessment, the LAC Health Nurse will provide you with a new form.
