Dear Consultee

In line with the requirements of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 and School Organisation Code 2018, we are writing to inform you about the Decision Notice issued in connection with the following proposal.

On 7th April 2021, Caerphilly County Borough Council's Cabinet agreed the proposal to relocate **Ysgol Gymraeg Cwm Gwyddon** to a new purpose built Welsh-medium provision school to be situated on the vacant site of the former Cwmcarn High School providing 420 primary places plus 60 Nursery, 16 Special Resource Base and accommodation for rising 3's.

The Cabinet considered the proposal, the statutory objections submitted, the Local Authority response and the recommendations of the Education Scrutiny Committee held on the 22nd March 2021.

It was noted that there were 2 statutory objections received. The concerns raised are summarised in the Objection Report together with the responses from the Local Authority.

Referral of local authority decisions to the Welsh Ministers

Under section 54 of the School Standards and Organisations (Wales) Act 2013 where a proposal has been approved by a local authority the following bodies may, before the end of 28 days beginning with the day of the decision, refer the proposal to the Welsh Ministers for consideration:

- Another local authority affected by the proposal
- The appropriate religious body for any school affected;
- The governing body of a voluntary or foundation school subject to the proposal;
- A trust holding property on behalf of a voluntary or foundation school subject to the proposal; and
- A further education institution affected by the proposal.
