Council Tax

The draft budget proposals for 2022/23 include a proposed Council Tax increase of 2.5%. This equates to a 59p weekly increase for an average band D property and is the lowest increase since 2017. This level of increase, combined with the funding received from Welsh Government, will allow the Council to invest a total of £10million in service provision including £6million for social care services to support our most vulnerable residents.
