Key Points


- Total number of cases (Wales) 12,680 with 369 reported in the last 7 days (14th to 20th May)
- Total number of cases (ABUHB) 2,412 with 31 reported in the last 7 days (14th to 20th May)
- Total number of Deaths (Wales) 1,238 with 46 reported in the last 7 days (14th to 20th May)
- Total number of Deaths (ABUHB) 260 with 6 reported in the last 7 days (14th to 20th May)
- Number of tests done in one day (Wales) 1,565
- Number of tests done is increased but proportion of positives is decreasing; for example between 6th and 20th May proportion of positives is reduced from 37% to 30.3% in Newport LA.
- GP consultation rate for COVID-19 symptoms has overall been showing downward trend since 3rd May 2020: the rate fell from 37.7/100k on 3rd May to 24.4/110k on 20th May in Wales; and from 56.4/100k to 29.4 /100k in ABUHB area in the same period. The data showed a spike on 16th May which seems to be stabilising now.
- Number of COVID-19 like symptoms calls to NHS Direct and 111 has overall been showing downward trend since 3rd May 2020: the number fell from 121on 3rd May to 91 on 20th May in Wales; and from 28 to 22 in ABUHB area in the same period. The data showed a spike on 16th May which seems to be stabilising now.
- Hospital inpatient data also shows downwards trends
- ONS data show that between week 11 and 19, COVID-19 deaths accounted for 25% of all deaths in Wales and 29% of all deaths in Gwent
- CIW data show 2,377 deaths in adult care homes residents since the 1 March 2020. Of them 24% (571) are COVID-19 suspected or confirmed deaths.


Figure 1. Overview

Figure 2. All Wales summary






Cumulative incidence, by Local Authority of residence*










Figure 3. All Wales positive cases and tests







Figure 4. ABUHB positive cases and tests




Figure 6. Number of deaths – Wales & HBS

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Figure 7. GP consultation rates - Wales





Figure 9. Number of calls to NHS Direct & 111 – Wales

Figure 10. Number of calls to NHS Direct & 111 - ABUHB







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Fig 11. ABUHB admissions data

COVID-19 Positive Critical Care Occupied Beds




Chart 1: Notifications of deaths of residents received from adult care homes, includes deaths from all causes (7 day rolling average), 7 January to 15 May 2020


