1. Introduction

Caerphilly County Borough Council is the fifth largest Authority in Wales with 73 Elected Members covering 33 wards. It employs approximately 10,300 staff, making it the largest employer in the area, delivering a wide range of diverse services to the 169,519 people who live in the county borough according to the 2001 Census figures.

Those Census figures also give an indication of the diverse nature of the population receiving those services and this booklet is designed to give an overview of that diversity on a ward-by-ward basis.

In the following pages are profiles of each of the 33 electoral wards, based on Equalities issues, gathered from the information available from the 2001 Census. Each ward profile, listed alphabetically, has a map showing where in the county borough the ward is located and has local population information, both numbers and percentages, on the following groups of people within those areas:-

- Female / Male population
- 0-25 age group
- 50+ age group, with 65+ also shown
- Welsh speakers
- · Permanently sick or disabled
- Ethnic minorities

The information gives an insight into different groups within the county borough population, and may also be useful data for organisations who are making local project funding bids for example, or to schools in terms of local information as part of social development work.

Aberbargoed

The population of the ward is 3,558

- The gender make up of Aberbargoed is approximately 51% Female (1,817 people) & 49% Male (1,741 people).
- Children and young people **aged 0 25 years old** represent approximately **34.7%** of the population, or around **1,233** people.
- Over 50's represent approximately 33.6% of the population, or around 1,196 people and approximately 601 of those are over 65.
- The number of Welsh speakers has risen by 62% since 1991 and there are now approximately 323 Welsh speakers in Aberbargoed, or 9.1% of the ward population.
- Approximately 40% (1,423 people) of people aged 16-74 are permanently sick or disabled.
- Approximately 0.5% of the population come from an ethnic minority background, which is far lower percentage than Wales as a whole (2.1%). However, this still means that approximately 18 people from an ethnic minority background live in the ward.



The population of the ward is 4,793

 The gender make up of Abercarn is approximately 51% Female (2,434 people) and 49% Male (2,359 people).

Abercarn

- The gender make up of Saint James is approximately 51% Female (3,035 people) & 49% Male (2,877 people).
- Children and young people aged 0 25 years old represent approximately 34.7% of the population, or around 2,051 people.
- Over 50's represent approximately 32.2% of the population, or around 1,905 people and approximately 735 of those are over 65.
- The number of Welsh speakers has risen by 3% since 1991 and there are now approximately 632 Welsh speakers in Saint James, or 10.7% of the ward population.
- Approximately 25% (1,478 people) of people aged 16-74 are permanently sick or disabled.
- Approximately 1.6% of the population come from an ethnic minority background, which is far lower percentage than Wales as a whole (2.1%). However, this still means that approximately 95 people from an ethnic minority background live in the ward.



30 Saint Martins

The population of the ward is **7,293**

- Approximately **14%** (1,021 people) of people aged 16-74 are permanently sick or disabled.
- Approximately 2.5% of the population come from an ethnic minority background, which is a higher percentage than Wales as a whole (2.1%). This means that approximately 182 people from an ethnic minority background live in the ward.





31 Twyn Carno

The population of the ward is 2,374

- The gender make up of Twyn Carno is approximately 51% Female (1,203 people) & 49% Male (1,171 people).
- Children and young people aged 0 25 years old represent approximately **33.9%** of the population, or around **804** people.

- The number of Welsh speakers has risen by 4% since 1991 and there are now approximately 248 Welsh speakers in Twyn Carno, or **10.4%** of the ward population.

- Approximately **0.8%** of the population come from an **ethnic minority** background, which is far lower percentage than Wales as a whole (2.1%). However, this still means that approximately 19 people from an ethnic minority background live in the ward.



32 Ynysddu

The population of the ward is 3,698

- The gender make up of Ynysddu is approximately 50% Female (1,834 people) & 50% Male (1,864 people).
- Children and young people aged 0 25 years old represent approximately **33.5%** of the population, or around **1,231** people.
- Over 50's represent approximately 32.6% of the population, or around **1,205** people and approximately **538** of those are over 65.
- The number of Welsh speakers has risen by 163% since 1991 • and there are now approximately 403 Welsh speakers in Ynysddu, or **10.9%** of the ward population.
- Approximately 22% (806 people) of people aged 16-74 are permanently sick or disabled.
- Approximately **0.8%** of the population come from an **ethnic minority** background, which is far lower percentage than Wales as a whole (2.1%). However, this still means that approximately 30 people from an ethnic minority background live in the ward.



33 Ystrad Mynach

The population of the ward is 4,077

- The gender make up of Ystrad Mynach is approximately 52% Female (2,099 people) & 48% Male (1,978 people).
- Children and young people **aged 0 25 years old** represent approximately **29.1%** of the population, or around **1,185** people.
- Over 50's represent approximately 36.5% of the population, or around 1,487 people and approximately 711 of those are over 65.
- The number of Welsh speakers has risen by 48% since 1991 and there are now approximately 444 Welsh speakers in Ystrad Mynach, or 10.9% of the ward population.
- Approximately 22% (897 people) of people aged 16-74 are permanently sick or disabled.
- Approximately 1.2% of the population come from an ethnic minority background, which is far lower percentage than Wales as a whole (2.1%). However, this still means that approximately 49 people from an ethnic minority background live in the ward.
