Description of Privacy Notice:	This privacy notice will explain how Caerphilly County Borough Council will use the information you provide to assess your entitlement to free school meals for your child/children.

How we will use your information

Purpose and legal basis for using your information

Purpose of processing

Caerphilly County Borough Council administer the Free School Meals scheme on behalf of the Welsh Government and will process your personal information to assess your entitlement to free school meals for your child/children.

Legal basis for processing

In order for the processing of personal data to be lawful under the General Data Protection Regulations 2016, a valid condition from Article 6 of the Regulations must be identified, which is outlined below:

1c. processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject i.e. Education Act 1996

1f. processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests

The information you provide may be shared with other government agencies to enable us to determine your eligibility for free school meals and to identify and detect fraud i.e. the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP), Welsh Government and Her Majesty's Revenues & Customs (HMRC).
