# How we will use your information

# Purpose and legal basis for using your information

#### **Purpose of processing**

Caerphilly County Borough Council will process your application for renaming / adding a name to your property and provide you with a decision and any other associated documentation.

Your name and contact details will be recorded to inform you of the decision on your application and for financial purposes but will not be shared with others during the consultation process. Consultees will only be provided with your proposed house name and the confirmed address details.

#### Legal basis for processing

In order for the processing of personal data to be lawful under the General Data Protection Regulations 2016, a valid condition from Article 6 of the Act must be identified, which is outlined below:

1(e) processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller.

There is a public task obligation to process your information as detailed by the following:

#### Who will have access to your information

#### Identity of Data Controller and Data Protection Officer

#### Details of main users of your information

Staff within the Council's Street Naming and Numbering Team will register your application, your identity and contact details for the purpose of determining your application and providing you with a decision and any associated documentation.

Your name and contact details may be processed by the Corporate Finance Team if a refund of fee needs to be arranged.

#### Details of any sharing of your information within Caerphilly County Borough Council

When a decision is made on your application, the confirmed address details will be shared with Council Tax, Electoral Registration, Planning and Regeneration, Infrastructure, Housing, Property, Legal and Digital Services in order for them to update their address systems. No further information will be shared.

#### Details of any sharing of your information with other organisations

We will consult with Royal Mail to ensure there are no similar house names being used in the vicinity.

When a decision is made on your application, the confirmed address details will be shared with Emergency Services, Royal Mail, Land Registry, BT Open Reach, Valuation Office Agency and Private Sector Housing in order for them to update their address systems. No further information will be shared.

#### **Requests for information**

All recorded information held by Caerphilly County Borough Council may be subject to requests under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, Environmental Information Regulations 2004 and Data Protection legislation.

If the information you provide is subject to such a request, where possible, Caerphilly County Borough Council will consult with you on its release. If you object to the release of your information, we will withhold your information if the relevant legislation allows.

#### How long will we retain your information?

#### **Details of retention period**

How long Caerphilly County Borough Council retains information is determined through statutory requirements or best practice.

We will retain your application / details for 7 years.
