## Aberbargoed Primary School Experimental Pedestrian and Cycle Zone - Caerphilly Traffic Order 2020.

**NOTICE** is hereby given that Caerphilly County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make the above order, the effect of which will be to:

Prohibit any motor vehicle (except School Zone Permit holders for Zone ZA and Disabled Persons Badge Holders) from entering or proceeding along the whole length of Heol Ysgol Newydd, Aberbargoed during school term-time, Monday to Friday, 8.10 - 9.10am and 2.30 - 3.30pm.

The experimental Order will be for a period of eighteen months from 1st September 2020 during which time the Council is to consider whether the provisions of this Order shall continue in force indefinitely and the Head of Infrastructure acting on behalf of the Council may make any relevant changes as necessary, on safety grounds, or terminate the experiment if, in his opinion, the need arises within the first six months.

If you wish to object to the making of this Order for the purpose of indefinite continuation you should make any objection in writing stating the grounds on which your objection is made to [jameshm@caerphilly.gov.uk](mailto:jameshm@caerphilly.gov.uk) no later than six months of this Order coming into force.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or any provisions contained within it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from the date below apply to the High Court for this Purpose
