**Cardiff Road Railway Bridge
7.5 Tonnes Weight Caerphilly
Temporary Prohibition of Driving
Order 2020**

NOTICE is hereby given that Caerphilly County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, the effect will of which will be to introduce a temporary road closure for vehicles in excess of 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight on the following length of road.

Cardiff Road, Caerphilly over the railway bridge between its junctions with Bartlett Street and St Martins Road.

Duration: The proposed Order is a continuation of an emergency Traffic Order dated 17th August 2020 for a period not exceeding 18 months.

No Access to any vehicle in excess of 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight will be permitted.

An alternative route will be available via Cardiff Road, Castle Street, Nantgarw Road, Lon-y-Llyn and St Martins Road.

Or via St Martins Road, Lon-y-Llyn, Nantgarw Road, Ton-y-Felin Road, Bedwas Road, Castle Street, Market Street, White Street and Bartlett Street.

- **Required By: Transport for Wales**
- **Transport for Wales to protect the structure and ensure the safety of both road and rail users following a structural assessment of the railway bridge**
