**Temporary Prohibition
of Pedestrians Order 2021**

NOTICE is hereby given that Caerphilly County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along:

That section of Footpath Numbers 176 and 178 in Risca.

The alternative route for pedestrians and cyclists will be available via the adjacent highway network.

The temporary order will be effective from Tuesday 23rd November 2021 up to a maximum duration of six months or until the works are completed.

The closure is required by Caerphilly County Borough Council.

The reason for making the Order is for relining works to Monmouthshire and Brecon Canal.
