CORNER OF THE PLOT OF LAND ADJACENT TO NO. 3 FAIRFIELD CLOSE,
BLACKWOOD
ONE-WAY TRAFFIC ORDER 2020

The Caerphilly County Borough Council (the 'Council') in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the 'Act') and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the day of 2020 and may be cited as the Caerphilly County Borough Council (Lane from Gordon Road to the north east corner of the plot of land adjacent to No. 3 Fairfield Close, Blackwood) (One-Way Traffic) Order 2020.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, police community support officer or of a traffic warden in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, other than in the direction shown, on the length of road identified as one-way traffic on the plan attached to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall prohibit the following vehicles from proceeding in the lengths of road:
 - a. Emergency service vehicles
 - b. Vehicles used in the service of a local authority for highway maintenance or environmental services
 - c. Vehicles used in the service of a public utility for maintenance of apparatus in pursuance of its statutory duties.
