

CAERPHILLY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL
BWL ROAD, NELSON
EXPERIMENTAL ONE-WAY TRAFFIC WITH CONTRAFLOW CYCLE LANE ORDER 2021

The Caerphilly County Borough Council ('the Council') in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the 'Act') and all other enabling powers and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1 This Order may be cited as the Caerphilly County Borough Council (Bwl Road, Nelson) (Experimental One-Way Traffic with Contraflow Cycle Lane) Order 2021 and shall come into operation on the xxxx day of March 2021

2 In this order

Cycle has the same meaning as in Section 192 of the Road Traffic Act 1988, namely a bicycle, a tricycle, or a cycle having four or more wheels, not being in any case a motor vehicle. Electrically assisted cycles meeting the Electrically Assisted Pedal Cycles (EAPC) requirements are classed as a cycle.

Cycle lane means the area of the carriageway along Bwl Road which is designated as a contraflow cycle lane shared with pedestrians.

3 Save as provided in Article 4 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable or police community support officer, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, other than in the northbound direction shown, on the length of Bwl Road identified as one-way traffic on the plan attached to this Order, except for the riding of a cycle in a southbound direction only in the designated cycle lane.

4 Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall prohibit the following vehicles from proceeding, other than in the direction shown' in the length of road identified as one-way traffic on the plan attached to this Order:

- a. Emergency service vehicles
- b. Vehicles used in the service of a local authority for highway maintenance or environmental services
- c. Vehicles used in the service of a public utility for maintenance of apparatus in pursuance of its statutory duties.

5 The experimental order will be for a period of eighteen months during which time the Council will consider whether the provision of this order shall continue in force indefinitely. The Head of Infrastructure acting on behalf of the Council may terminate or modify the experiment if, in his opinion, the need arose on safety grounds within the first six months.
