The way in which the council maintains its large portfolio of land is changing and the onset of the global pandemic in March 2020 transformed the way in which we undertook routine maintenance as a result of the national and local lockdowns. At the start of the pandemic in March 2020, one of the many services paused was grass cutting and this had an unexpected and welcome impact on our environment as we had inadvertently created many wildlife habitats and havens for pollinators. Some of our community spaces became a sea of wildflowers. Changing our approach to grass-cutting provides an opportunity to reduce the resources deployed by 4 agency staff for the cutting period.

This proposal would have a positive impact in that it would enhance our local environment and create habit for wildlife and areas where wildflowers could flourish. It will also assist with resident's physical and mental well-being regardless of any protected characteristics. This proposal may encourage younger people to gain an appreciation of their local environment which they will have the opportunity to develop and apply throughout their lives.

Areas left to flourish may give an untidy and unmanaged appearance, which could result in complaints from residents. This will be mitigated by relevant signage and maintenance of the edges will continue to prevent overgrowth affecting pedestrians. If appropriate, desire lines or walking routes will also be cut.

Long-term guidance: protection of the biodiversity of the areas will support the habitats of pollinators preventing decline in their numbers.

Prevention guidance: Without pollinators food production cannot happen.

In October 2021, consultation was undertaken with all elected members to identify areas within their respective wards which could be allowed to flourish during the summer of 2022. The details of which was reported to the Environment and Sustainability Scrutiny Committee in October 2021 and subsequently Cabinet. The approach outlined was unanimously supported by both committees. In October 2022, an all-members seminar was held and a further report is due to be considered by both Scrutiny Committee and Cabinet to identify additional areas across the county borough which can be managed in an alternative way to enhance biodiversity and assist with the climate emergency which the council declared in2019.

There was general support for the proposal to reduce the frequency of grass cutting improve biodiversity. Where there was disagreement with this proposal it was through concern over the visual appearance of the county borough.
