Licensed hackney carriage and private hire vehicle drivers have a legal duty to comply with the following

- (i) To carry guide, hearing and certain prescribed dogs, accompanying a disabled person who has hired his or her taxi and to do so without any additional charge.
- (ii) Sections 165 of the Equality Act 2010 requires the drivers of wheelchair accessible vehicles to carry passengers in wheelchairs, provide assistance to those passengers and prohibits them from charging extra.

Provisions exist for drivers with certain medical conditions to apply to the Council for exemption from these duties.

#### **Medical Conditions**

- (a) Conditions aggravated by exposure to dogs which renders the driver unable to drive or continue to drive hackney carriage and private hire vehicles.
- (b) Physical conditions which render the driver unable to load passengers seated in wheelchairs into wheelchair accessible hackney carriage or private hire vehicles.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

Caerphilly County Borough Council (as the licensing authority) is responsible for licensing drivers of hackney carriages and private hire vehicles. Where a driver has a bona fide condition which prevents them from complying with the legal duties below they may make application for an exemption certificate from the Council. However the Council needs to be satisfied that it is appropriate to do so on medical grounds verified by the driver's own physician / GP.
