**Nine Mile Point / Islwyn Road, Crosskeys
Temporary Prohibition of Driving Order 2022**

NOTICE is hereby given that Caerphilly County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from proceeding along-

Nine Mile Point/Islwyn Road, Crosskeys from its junctions with B4251 roundabout and Llanarth Street, Cwmfelin-fach.

The proposed Order is expected to commence on 4 November 2022 for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is expected the works will be completed by 10 November 2022.

Emergency service, pedestrian and resident access will be maintained.

Alternative routes are via A467, A472, B4251.

The reason for making the Order is to allow for installation of missing speed cushions.

The Order is required by Caerphilly County Borough Council.
