Garfield Street

- Ochr ddwyreiniol o'r gyffordd â Gordon Road am bellter o 18 metr
- Ochr orllewinol o'r gyffordd â Gordon Road am bellter o 15 metr

Coronation Road

- Ochr ddwyreiniol o'r gyffordd â Woodbine Road i rif 6 Coronation Road
- Ochr dwyreiniol o'r gyffordd gyda'r lôn fynediad i Mayhill Bungalows i rif 24 Coronation Road
- Ochr dwyreiniol o'r gyffordd gyda'r lôn fynediad i Mayhill Bungalows i rif 32 Coronation Road
- Ochr ddwyreiniol o'r gyffordd â'r lôn y tu ôl i'r gyfnewidfa ffôn i rif 70 Coronation Road

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING ORDER 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that Caerphilly County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, which will have the effect of temporarily prohibiting waiting on the following lengths of:

Gordon Road

- Northern side from its junction with Fairfield Close to no. 42 Gordon Road
- Southern side from its junction with Garfield Street to no. 33 Gordon Road
- Southern side from its junction with Garfield Street to no. 23 Gordon Road

Garfield Street

- Eastern side from its junction with Gordon Road for a distance of 18 metres
- Western side from its junction with Gordon Road for a distance of 15 metres

Coronation Road

- Eastern side from its junction with Woodbine Road to no. 6 Coronation Road
- Eastern side from its junction with the access lane to Mayhill Bungalows to no. 24 Coronation Road
- Eastern side from its junction with the access lane to Mayhill Bungalows to no. 32 Coronation Road
- Eastern side from its junction with the lane to the rear of the telephone exchange to no. 70 Coronation Road
- Eastern side from its junction with the lane to the rear of the telephone exchange for a distance of 16 metres in a southerly direction
- Western side from its junction with Woodbine Road to no. 7 Coronation Road
- Western Side from no. 21 Coronation Road to no. 35 Coronation Road
- Western Side from no. 65 Coronation Road to no. 77 Coronation Road

The proposed Order is expected to commence on 30 August 2024 for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. It is anticipated the works will be complete by 30 August 2024.

The Order does not apply to vehicles being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

The reason for making the Order is to ensure suitable access to Mayhill Bungalows is maintained during construction works.
