(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and on Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2019 (Amendment Order No 24) 2023

Proposed Revocation of existing Double Yellow Lines and Replace with Coach Parking Bay, Castle Street, Caerphilly

NOTICE is hereby given that Caerphilly County Borough Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police have made an order the effect of which is:-

The order will revoke a length of double yellow lines, extend the existing bus stop layby and provide 2 short stay visitor coach parking bays at that location.

The Order shall come into operation on 13 December 2023.

A copy of the Order as made, plans showing the parts of the highway affected and a statement of the traffic authority's reasons for making the Order can be viewed at www.caerphilly.gov.uk/TrafficRegulationsOrders and may also be inspected free of charge by appointment at Caerphilly County Borough Council Legal Services, Penallta House, Tredomen Park, Ystrad Mynach, Hengoed, CF82 7PG between the hours of 09:00 and 17:00 Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays and public holidays) from 13/12/2023 to 24/1/2024 quoting reference SCF/5010081.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the grounds that any requirement of that Act made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within six weeks of the date hereof apply to the Court for this purpose.
